NAVIGATION ADVISORY NOTICE



RIVER GREAT OUSE, ELY OUSE SYSTEM AND TRIBUTARIES

DATE: 20 December 2019 – Until Further Notice

DETAILS:

We are currently experiencing high levels of rainfall across the region.

Over the next few days it may become necessary to increase and maximise the discharge of flood water at the Denver Complex to lower the flood risk to communities living by our navigable rivers.

In order to do this we may have to lower river levels at times to create additional capacity to accommodate flood waters travelling down the river system.

Please be aware that this could result in larger, deeper drafted boats grounding in some locations. Please ensure that you check your vessel regularly and allow enough slack in your vessel mooring lines to accommodate fluctuating water levels.
